ZAMBIA PROJECT:



Recently, DNS was able to purchase and send 450 GALCOM audio devices (solar) to Zambia in response to a request for more. These devices contain “God’s Story” and the Lunda New Testament.

Last year, a chapel in Canada sent approx. 350 devices and many were delivered to a village where 2 DNS wells had been dug. Reports came in of seeing people going about their daily work listening to the little devices and many people came to the missionaries asking for more.

The devices are presently enroute. Please pray for their safe and timely arrival and the Lord’s direction in who they are given to.



MINISTRY REPORT FROM INDIA:

Wells that were dug with the support of DNS and prayer partners continue to be an opening for the Gospel in many villages. Clean water is a blessing!

These 2 men (left) have been entrusted with the duty of Bore-well maintenance and keeping connection with each village while continuing to share Christ.

There are 50 requests from other villages for clean drinking water. Workers are praying about installing 10-12 units this year with support from DNS.



Due to Covid-19, tribal youths have returned to their respective villages. **Bible Classes** are being conducted for them and many are very interested and committing to the Lord.

Bible Training is needed. 35 people are ready to join the one year Training School, though Covid-19 has delayed training at this point. Provisions, Bible teachers and support staff are needed.



(Above left - a family praying to the Lord for salvation.) **The work of the Lord is growing** and many are coming to faith. People are very thirsty for the Lord - many new villages are receiving the Gospel for the first time. Also, over the last two months, care packages have been provided for many families who are suffering due to Covid-19.



As the believers increase in each village, they have a need for **assembly halls** for gathering. The average cost is \$2500-\$3500 USD. Four are now under construction.
